## **Signature Manager Plugin Description**

The following will be a detailed description of the proposed User, Admin, and Technical interfaces for the Signature Manager Plugin you've requested that I develop.

### **User Interface**

There will be no actual user interface for this plugin. If a user happens upon a post where the author has elected to display his or her signature, the user will see the signature.

### **Admin Interface**

The admin interface applies to all users of your WordPress blog that have the ability to write a post. The author will do the following to setup and use his or her signature:

1. Author will login to WordPress backend.
2. Author will navigate to Admin Settings and then to the Signature Management tab.
3. Author will enter his or her signature and specify the default settings for the plugin.
4. Author will navigate to Write / Edit Post screen and prepare his or her post as normal.
5. Author, if he or she chooses, may scroll down to the Signature Options dialog on the Write / Edit post screen and toggle the signature on or off depending on his or her default setting.

### **Technical Interface**

This plugin will be developed for WordPress 2.6.1. No extra tables will be created within the WordPress database. Author signatures and default settings will be stored within the user\_postmeta table within the WordPress database.
